

Instructions for bringing a fish into the Wainsford Hatchery

1. Only donate a fish if you are sure of the following :
 - It is a coloured, sexually mature fish.
 - There was not excessive bleeding when un-hooking
 - Is the hook is still in the fish .? Visible hooks can be removed under anaesthetic.
 - The fish is fully recovered
2. Put the fish in the correct tank – outside at the rear of the Hatchery
 - Tanks are marked [Fowey Hen], [Fowey Cock], [Camel Hen] & [Camel Cock]
 - Ensure the netting top is firmly re-secured over the tank – stretch over the pins
3. Complete the registration form – please be as accurate as possible
